AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING ONE-SIDE PARKING AND ONE-WAY TRAFFIC SCHEME FOR BARANGAY U.P. VILLAGE, QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 458(a)(5)(v) and (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides for the Powers, Duties, Functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as follows:

“(v) Regulates the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalk, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same, xxx.

“(vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon and, when necessary, in the interest of public welfare, xxx.”;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay U.P. Village, District IV, Quezon City adopted Resolution No. 024, Series of 2021 entitled:

“A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY COUNCIL TO ENACT AN ORDINANCE ON ONE SIDE PARKING AND ONE WAY TRAFFIC SCHEME FOR BARANGAY U.P. VILLAGE.”;

WHEREAS, because of limited garage spaces for private cars of some residents, transients and visitors aggravated on occasions during the holidays, gatherings, parties and other legitimate activities, parking on the street has become inevitable.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as “One-Side Parking and One-Way Traffic Scheme within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay U.P. Village, Quezon City.”

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. – All motorists, residents and non-residents, passing through the streets of Barangay U.P. Village shall comply with this new Barangay Traffic Scheme.

SECTION 3. ONE-SIDE PARKING. – One-side parking in the following streets shall be allowed:

- a. *Matiwasay* – from *Manigo* to *Maginhawa* – Right side;
- b. *Manigo* – from *Matiwasay* to *Malinis* – Right side;
- c. *Malusog* – from *Matiwasay* to *Malinis* – Left side;
- d. *Mahusay* – from *Matiwasay* to *Malinis* – Left side;
- e. *Malinis* – from *Malusog* to *Matiwasay* – Left side;
- f. *Mahinhin* – from *Malamig* to *Mayaman* – Left side;
- g. *Malumanay* – from *Malamig* to *Mayaman* – Right side;
- h. *Maayusin* – from *Mahusay* to *Malambing* – Right side;
- i. *Mapayapa* – from *Maayusin* to *Mahusay* – Right side;
- j. *Malambing* – from *Maayusin* to *Marilag* – Left side;
- k. *Marilag* – from *Mahusay* to *Maayusin* – Left side;
- l. *Maalindog* – from *Upper Maayusin* to *Lower Maayusin* – Left side;

- m. Maayusin – from corner Maalindog to Marilag – Left side;
- n. Maayusin – from Lower Maalindog to Upper Maalindog – Right side;
- o. Matahimik – from Mayaman to Malamig – Left side.

SECTION 4. NO PARKING ON BOTH SIDES. – Parking on both sides of the following streets shall not be allowed:

- a. Malinis – from Malusog to Mahusay;
- b. Mapagkawanggawa – U.P. Village side;
- c. Matimtiman – U.P. Village side;
- d. Mahinhin – from Matimtiman to Malamig – U.P. Village side;
- e. Mayumi – from Mahinhin to Maginhawa during school days;
- f. Matiwasay – from Mayumi to Manigo;
- g. Manigo – from Mayaman to Matiwasay;
- h. Mayaman – from Maharlika to Kalayaan Avenue;
- i. Maharlika and Masaya – U.P. Village side;
- j. Marilag – from Maayusin to Maginhawa;
- k. Mahusay – from Malinis to Malambing;
- l. Mayaman – from Maginhawa to Maharlika;
- m. Maayusin – from Mahusay to upper Maalindog;
- n. Masaya Street and Maharlika Street UP Village side;
- o. Malamig Street, UP Village side, during school days;
- p. Matahimik, during school days.

SECTION 5. ONE-WAY STREETS. – The following streets are hereby declared as one-way thoroughfares:

- a. Manigo – from Matiwasay to Malinis;
- b. Malusog – from Matiwasay to Malinis;
- c. Mahusay – from Matiwasay to Maginhawa;
- d. Malinis – from Malusog to Matiwasay;
- e. Matiwasay – from Malinis to Manigo;
- f. Maalindog – from Upper Maayusin to Lower Maayusin;
- g. Maayusin – from Lower Maalindog to Upper Maalindog;
- h. Maayusin – from Mahusay to Malambing;
- i. Mapayapa – from Maayusin to Mahusay;
- j. Malambing – from Maayusin to Mahusay;
- k. Marilag – from Malambing to Maayusin;
- l. Mahinhin – from Malamig to Mayaman;

- m. Malumanay – from Malamig to Mayaman;
- n. Matahimik – from Mayaman to Malamig;
- o. Mayaman – from Maginhawa to Maharlika;
- p. Masaya – from Maharlika to Maginhawa;
- q. Matiwasay – from Malinis to Maginhawa;
- r. Maayusin – Lower Maalindog to Marilag.

SECTION 6. NO ENTRY. – Entry in the following streets shall not be allowed:

- a. Mahinhin – from Mayaman;
- b. Malumanay – from Mayaman;
- c. Matahimik – from Malamig;
- d. Masaya – from Maginhawa;
- e. Mayaman – from Maharlika;
- f. Matiwasay – from Maginhawa;
- g. Mahusay – from Maginhawa to UPRA III;
- h. Marilag – from Maayusin;
- i. Maayusin – from Marilag;
- j. Mapayapa – from Mahusay;
- k. Malambing – from Mahusay.

SECTION 7. INSTALLATION OF SIGNAGES. – The Traffic and Transport Management Department and Barangay UP Village are hereby mandated to install traffic signages indicating that the street is regulated to inform motorists, drivers, vehicle owners and the public in general.

SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. – The Quezon City Traffic and Transport Management Department, Barangay Traffic Enforcer and Barangay Public Safety Officers of Barangay U.P. Village shall promulgate and issue the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9. PENALTIES. – All penalties, fines, or surcharges shall be the same as those prescribed under Ordinance No. SP-3172, S-2023 for motor vehicle violations.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances, executive orders, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If, for any reason, parts or provisions of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.
