ORDINANCE NO. SP- **3354**, S-2024

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ONE-WAY TRAFFIC SCHEME AT ANAHAW STREET (FROM PAYNA STREET TO DUHAT STREET), NARIG STREET (FROM DANGAY STREET TO LANUTAN STREET), AND DUHAT STREET (FROM LANUTAN STREET TO DANGAY STREET), BARANGAY VETERANS VILLAGE, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that:

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*“Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.”*

*WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Veterans Village adopted Barangay Resolution No. 84, Series of 2024 entitled “A Resolution Urging the 22<sup>nd</sup> City Council to Pass an Ordinance making Anahaw Street from Payna Street to Duhat Street as One-Way Street” and Barangay Resolution No. 102, Series of 2024 entitled “A Resolution Urging the 22<sup>nd</sup> City Council to Pass an Ordinance making Narig Street from Dangay Street going to Lanutan Street and Dangay Street from Lanutan Street to Dangay Street”;*

*WHEREAS, due to the continuous commercial development in the vicinity, the volume of vehicular traffic, particularly along Anahaw Street (from Payna Street to Duhat Street), Narig Street (from Dangay Street to Lanutan Street), and Duhat Street (from Lanutan Street to Dangay Street), has commensurately increased;*

*WHEREAS, the designation of one-way traffic schemes will decongest traffic, avoiding unnecessary delays and loss of precious time and resources;*

*WHEREAS, after the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Veterans Village consulted with the Traffic and Transportation Management Department of Quezon City; said Department interposed no objection on designating a One-way Traffic Scheme at Anahaw Street (from Payna Street to Duhat Street), Narig Street (from Dangay Street to Lanutan Street), and Duhat Street (from Lanutan Street to Dangay Street);*

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WHEREAS, Section 458(a)(5)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, which enumerates the Powers, Duties, and Functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod provides:

*“(vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges, prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon, and when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal or encroachments and illegal constructions in public space.”*

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as the “One-Way Traffic Ordinance of Barangay Veterans Village, Quezon City.”

SECTION 2. One-way traffic flow shall be applied to the following streets in Barangay Veterans Village, District I, Quezon City:

- a. Anahaw Street – from Payna Street going towards Duhat Street;
- b. Narig Street – from Dangay Street going towards Lanutan Street; and
- c. Duhat Street – from Lanutan Street going towards Dangay Street.

SECTION 3. INSTALLATION OF SIGNAGES. – The Traffic and Transport Management Department (TTMD) and Barangay Veterans Village are hereby mandated to install traffic signages indicating that the street is regulated to inform motorists, drivers, vehicle owners and the public in general.

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. – The TTMD of Quezon City shall formulate and issue the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. PENALTIES. – The City, through its Deputized Traffic Enforcers, shall issue an Ordinance Violation Receipt (OVR) and shall charge penalties, fines, or surcharges prescribed under Ordinance No. SP-3172, S-2023, otherwise known as the Metro Manila Traffic Code of 2023, for motor vehicle violations.

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
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*SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.*

*SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance shall take effect after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation, and after posting of copies in conspicuous locations within Quezon City.*
