WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) is the primary government agency responsible for the development and regulation of a dependable, safe, and efficient transportation system in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government (QCG), under Republic Act No. 537, otherwise known as the Revised Charter of Quezon City and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, is mandated to provide and maintain adequate transportation facilities to meet the needs of its residents;

WHEREAS, the DOTr and QCG have identified the need to establish active transport infrastructure and support facilities in Quezon City as part of the National Transport Policy and pursuant to DOH, DOTr, DILG and DPWH Joint Administrative Order No. 2020-001 promoting active transport during and after the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, there is a need to execute a Memorandum of Agreement specifying that the DOTr will transfer funds amounting to Three Hundred One Million Nine Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Four Pesos and Thirty-Seven Centavos (Php301,994,124.37) to the QCG to implement the Active Transport Program, which includes constructing bike lanes, pedestrian walkways, and other support facilities within Quezon City;

WHEREAS, this partnership aligns with the objectives of promoting sustainable transportation, reducing carbon emissions, and improving public health and safety by providing adequate infrastructure for active transport.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Transportation (DOTr) for the establishment of active transport infrastructure and support facilities in Quezon City, subject to all existing laws, rules, and regulations.
