Said athletes competed in various sports including table tennis, swimming, boccia, chess, badminton, wheelchair basketball, athletics, archery and powerlifting;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City delegation demonstrated exceptional skills and determination, winning a total of 9 gold medals, 11 silver medals, and 5 bronze medals, contributing significantly to the overall success of the games and securing a Top 10 Overall Ranking, finishing in 10th place;

WHEREAS, the impressive achievements of the Quezon City athletes serve as a testament to the fact that disabilities are not obstacles but rather sources of inspirations and strength, proving that through courage, perseverance and self-belief, all goals are attainable;
