AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE ACQUISITION OF GOODS AND SERVICES THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT (EMERGENCY CASES)

WHEREAS, Quezon City Council issued Resolution No. SP-10181, S-2025 known as "A resolution declaring a State of Calamity in Quezon City due to the effects of severe tropical storm Wipha (Crising) and the enhanced Southwest Monsoon (Habagat), Authorizing the utilization of available City and Barangay Calamity Funds, and for Other Purposes;

WHEREAS, the end-user, Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office has requested the Emergency Procurement of various veterinary supplies for pet wellness, pet adoption, veterinary responses during calamities;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35.2 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 12009, which provides that Negotiated Procurement (Emergency Cases) as a mode of procurement whereby it may be resorted to in case of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or when is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities or other causes where immediate action is necessary to prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or to restore vital public services, infrastructure facilities and other public utilities;

WHEREAS, DEGE TRADING participated in and submitted its quotation on the project for evaluation and passed the post qualification process and may now be considered and declared as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Offer, to wit:
