A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, ON BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION PESOS (PHP5,000,000.00) TO FUND THE PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE QUEZON CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (QCPSTA) FOR THE YEAR 2025, TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATION FOR GRANTS, AIDS, AND SUBSIDIES OF THE 2025 ANNUAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Public School Teachers Association (QCPSTA) is the official and duly recognized organization of teachers and non-teaching personnel under the Schools Division Office of Quezon City (SDO-QC). It is recognized by the Philippine Public School Teachers Association as its local affiliated chapter;

WHEREAS, the QCPSTA, with over sixteen thousand (16,000) members composed of teaching and non-teaching personnel, covers a total of one hundred fifty-eight (158) members schools;

WHEREAS, the declared principles and objectives of the QCPSTA are to promote the rights and welfare of public school teachers and employees and to be able to work for an educational system that contributes to the realization of a just, free, democratic, peaceful, and prosperous Philippines;

WHEREAS, the support aims to facilitate the implementation of activities aimed at aiding teachers in various aspects crucial for their effectiveness as educators, ultimately benefiting our public school students. Proposed activities include continuing education programs for teachers, annual leadership training seminars, medical assistance, and others;

WHEREAS, the QCPSTA, with its various welfare, training, and advocacy programs, is an important partner of the City Government in supporting teachers and employees, and ensuring quality education in the City.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, on behalf of the Quezon City Government, to extend financial assistance in the amount of Five Million Pesos (Php5,000,000.00) to fund the projects and activities of the Quezon City Public School Teachers Association (QCPSTA) for the year 2025, to be taken from the appropriations for grants, aids, and subsidies of the 2025 annual budget of Quezon City or from any available funds.
