WHEREAS, in Quezon City, MSMEs play a pivotal role in driving economic activity, fostering innovation, creating sustainable livelihoods, and contributing substantially to the City's Gross Domestic Product (GDP), making it a vibrant economic hub;

WHEREAS, MSMEs in Quezon City have demonstrated remarkable resilience, adaptability, and entrepreneurial spirit, particularly in navigating economic challenges and contributing to the City's recovery and sustained growth, serving as key drivers of local employment and wealth creation;

WHEREAS, the growth and sustainability of MSMEs are crucial for poverty reduction, equitable wealth distribution, and the overall socio-economic development of Quezon City, providing essential goods and services to its constituents and strengthening local supply chains;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State, as enshrined in Republic Act No. 6977, as amended by Republic Act No. 8289 and Republic Act No. 9501, otherwise known as the Magna Carta for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), to promote, support, strengthen, and encourage the growth and development of MSMEs;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, led by Honorable Mayor Josefina G. Belmonte and through its various departments and initiatives, has continuously strived to create an enabling environment for MSMEs, recognizing their unique challenges and immense potential for growth within the City's dynamic economic landscape;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes the need to create a more conducive, competitive, and inclusive business environment that supports the establishment, operation, and expansion of MSMEs within its jurisdiction, ensuring their long-term viability and success;

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to implementing robust policies and programs that streamline business processes, provide accessible financing options, offer comprehensive capacity-building initiatives, and ensure a level playing field for all enterprises operating within Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the City Council has demonstrated its commitment to the continuous review and enactment of ordinances and resolutions that will further simplify business registration and permitting processes unique to Quezon City, provide access to various forms of financial assistance tailored to local needs, offer relevant training and development programs designed for Quezon City entrepreneurs, and ensure the robust protection and promotion of MSME interests across all sectors in Quezon City.


RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Quezon City Government reiterates support in fostering a business environment conducive to sustainable growth and development.
