**RECONSTITUTING THE QUEZON CITY YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL
(QCYDC)**

WHEREAS, Section 13 of the 1987 Constitution recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being;

WHEREAS, Section 23 of Republic Act 10742 otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act provides that there shall be in every province, city, and municipality a Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) mandated to assist the planning and execution of projects and programs of the Sangguniang Kabataan, and the Pederasyon in all levels;

WHEREAS, the youth council shall serve as the main advocate for the youth participation in nation-building and youth empowerment, monitoring and implementation of the programs and projects under the Local Youth Development Plan;

WHEREAS, Section 24 (1) Rule III of the Rules and Regulations Implementing Republic Act 10742 states that the LYDC shall be composed of at least ten (10) but not more than twenty-one (21) members including the two (2) core members shall be composed of the president and the vice president of the concerned Pederasyon and shall be supported by at least eight (8) but not more than nineteen (19) other representatives from the registered youth or youth-serving organizations;

WHEREAS, the convening and election of members of the Quezon City Youth Development Council were conducted on September 7, 2024, spearheaded by the Quezon City Youth Development Office, in cooperation with the SK Pederasyon and in accordance with the DII.G Memorandum Circular 2018- 124 and NYC Certification No. 92.

NOW, THEREFORE I, MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, Mayor of Quezon City, by virtue of the power vested in me by the law, do hereby reconstitute the Quezon City Youth Development Council;

SECTION 1. RECONSTITUTION OF THE COUNCIL. The Quezon City Youth Development Council (QCYDC) is hereby reconstituted.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The QCYDC shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The QCYDC shall have the following duties and functions:

- 3.1 Serve as the core of the advocacy on youth participation in nation-building and youth empowerment;
- 3.2 Finalize the three (3) year Local Youth Development Plan (LYDP) that is anchored in the Philippine Youth Development Plan (PYDP) and the development plan of the City. This shall be submitted to the City Mayor for inclusion in the Local Development Plan and subsequently endorsed to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for approval. These plans shall be given priority to programs, projects, and activities that will promote and attain the thrusts of the PYDP such as health, education, environment, global mobility, active citizenship, governance, social inclusion and equity, peace-building and security, economic empowerment, and agriculture.
- 3.3 Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Youth Development Plan;
- 3.4 Coordinate with the National Youth Commission (NYC) and other agencies to achieve effectively the objectives and attain the goals of the LYDP;
- 3.5 Perform other functions as may be prescribed by law or ordinance relative to Quezon City youth programs or as the City Mayor, Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG).

SECTION 4. CONVENING OF THE LYDC. The LYDC shall schedule a meeting every quarter, and/or as often as needed.

SECTION 5. SECRETARIAT. The Local Youth Development Officer (LYDO) shall provide secretariat services to the Quezon City Youth Development Council. Accordingly, the

LYDO shall assist in the conduct of meetings, take charge of communications and notices, prepare reports, and take custody of all records, data information, and documents of the QCYDC.

SECTION 6. RESOURCE AVAILABILITY. Funds necessary to carry out operations and effective functioning of the QCYDC and its secretariat shall be sourced from the QC Youth Development Office or any available funds of the City in accordance with the accounting and auditing management and procedures, other existing laws, rules, and regulations.

SECTION 7. CONSISTENCY WITH LOCAL PLANS. For planning purposes, the initiatives emanating from the QCYDC shall be consistent with the Quezon City Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP), and Comprehensive Development Plan.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. Executive Order No. 24, Series of 2021, and other Orders and Issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part of this Order is held unconstitutional or invalid, other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. DISSEMINATION. A copy of this Executive Order shall be furnished to the Office of the President and the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) for information and guidance, pursuant to Section 455 (1) (xii) of RA 7160 as amended, and shall be posted at the Official website of the Quezon City Government.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately.
