DECLARATION OF THE ELIGIBLE FARMERS AND FISHERFOLK COOPERATIVE OR ENTERPRISE (FFCE) WITH THE BEST OFFER AND RECOMMENDING AWARD OF THE PROJECT CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF RICE FOR DISTRIBUTION TO QUEZON CITY RESIDENTS PROCURED THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT-SAGIP SAKA ACT

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through its Bids and Awards Committee – Goods and Services (BAC), undertook the procurement of **Supply and Delivery of Rice for distribution to Quezon City Residents** in accordance with Republic Act No. 11321, otherwise known as the “Sagip Saka Act,” its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and the **Guidelines for the Procurement of Agricultural and Fishery Products under Republic Act No. 11321** (GPPB Circular No. 02-2025 dated 25 September 2025), governing procurement through Negotiated Procurement under the said Act;

WHEREAS, consistent with the principles of transparency and wider participation, the procurement opportunity was posted and published on **March 30, 2026**, through the Farmers and Fisherfolk Enterprise Development Information System (FFEDIS), the Quezon City Government website, and in a conspicuous place reserved for such purpose, in accordance with Section 5.3 of the applicable Guidelines;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the said Guidelines, the BAC required the submission of eligibility and documentary requirements from participating Farmers and Fisherfolk Cooperatives or Enterprises (FFCEs);

WHEREAS, the BAC received **1 proposal(s)** from FFCE(s), and in accordance with the Guidelines, the receipt of at least one (1) proposal is sufficient to proceed with evaluation;

WHEREAS, the BAC conducted a careful evaluation of the eligibility of the FFCE(s) and the Responsiveness of their proposals, and disqualified those found non-compliant with the prescribed requirements;

WHEREAS, upon evaluation, the BAC determined that the FFCE is **eligible and compliant**, having satisfied the following:

- Registration in the FFEDIS, or submission of equivalent accreditation or registration documents issued by the Department of Agriculture, in accordance with applicable rules;
- Possession of the necessary capacity to deliver the required agricultural and fishery products in accordance with the specifications, quality standards, and quantities required; and
- Submission of complete documentary requirements, including the written proposal/offer, certificate of registration or equivalent document, and Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS);

WHEREAS, the BAC exercised due diligence in verifying the authenticity of the submitted documents and in assessing the capacity of the FFCE to supply the required goods within the prescribed period;

WHEREAS, the BAC likewise ensured compliance with applicable rules, including that the agricultural and fishery products to be supplied were not obtained through government assistance, subsidy, or project support, except in cases allowed under the Guidelines;

WHEREAS, after careful evaluation and validation, the BAC determined that the proposal submitted by the FFCE offers the **most advantageous terms to the government**, taking into consideration both quality and price, and within the allowable parameters under the applicable Guidelines;

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING, the members of the QUEZON CITY BAC-GOODS AND SERVICES hereby resolve the following:





- (1) To **DECLARE FFCE** as the **Eligible and Responsive FFCE with the Best Offer** for the procurement of **Supply and Delivery of Rice for distribution to Quezon City Residents**
- (2) To **RECOMMEND** to the Honorable City Mayor, as the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE), the **award of contract to the FFCE** in accordance with **Section 5.9 of the Guidelines for the Procurement of Agricultural and Fishery Products under the Sagip Saka Act**;
- (3) To further recommend that, upon approval, the HoPE shall issue the corresponding **Notice of Award (NOA)** to the said FFCE.
